## **Meeting Minutes**

March 5, 2022

### **I. Call to order**

### **IV. Open issues**

1. Paving/Patching Roads: Paving is complete. Grant recertification for North side has been submitted. Town portion approximately \$37,000. Possible send a letter requesting donations/pledges. Party with Kevin Stonerock (summer sometime).
2. Ordinances/Bylaws. Town Board agreed to revisit the town ordinances/bylaws. Town will go through the ordinances/bylaws and then bring them up before a town board meeting.
3. Police Department. Met with Director IPSIC, John Allen. As of March 4, 2022, IPSIC has created Greensboro a talk group – Greensboro Police Department. Will meet with the Commander of the Pendleton Police Dept. They and ISP will be the only ones who will be allowed to access the talk group. CADS system – Caliber Public Safety – IPSIC waiting on quote for pricing to have software on computers in vehicles. Chief has a meeting with the Prosecutor's Office on Monday, March 7<sup>th</sup> to discuss expectations of Town and Police Department. Chief will meet with Sheriff about going over Jail System procedures.
4. Greensboro Community Fund. Working on getting an Easter event going for April 16, 2022, and working on getting movie nights, etc. going for the

community. Someone will need to be CPR certified. Background checks on those who are volunteering to supervise.

5. Internet. Still waiting on installation. All we know is we are scheduled to have the installation done, but we don't know a date yet.
6. Audit. Documents submitted. Still waiting on information/approval from SBOA
7. Meetings. Board member, Mike Dawson, obtained new employment. Move back to Monday evenings?
